

Uerige Obergearige Hausbrauerei

Brewery Description:

Built in 1632 and converted to a brewpub in 1862, Uerige Brewery, named for the cranky owner, Wilhelm Cuerten, has established the Duesseldorfer interpretation of Altbier as the classic of the style. After the building was completely destroyed in World War II, the new owner, Rudi Arnold began reconstructing the brewpub in 1945. In 1949 he finished and in 1976 the Schnitzler family took over the company.



Altbier is Germany's answer to the copper colored pale ales of England and the fruity/estery interpretations of ales in Belgium. Whereas most German brewers abandoned old brewing methods for the new cold fermented pilsner style in the 1800's, the brewers in Düsseldorf continued with the old (alt) tradition of ale brewing at warmer temperatures. At around 4.5% alc./vol, traditional Altbier shows a rm bitterness, medium body, and a malty avor with hints of caramel. Relative to the other beers of this style"

■ *Spirits*

The Pinot Noir, Pinot Noir and frz., Italian Pinot Nero, Pinot Noir or Black Burgundy called, is a significant and very high quality grapes for red wine. The vine has so gained high importance and is so popular that they moved up the nobility of the wine world in and as noble vine is known. It is the classic red of the cooler growing areas such as in Burgundy, but also in almost all German regions. The Pinot Noir is also an important grape in the Champagne. The aging of Pinot Noir wines, it is difficult to predict and therefore risky. Fine wine from Burgundy can be very durable, and then develop very complex flavors. In general, the wine loses its charm.

The name "Pinot" is possibly the French word for pine cones ("pin borrowed") and is thus together with the shape of the grape.

Stickum Plus is distilled from Uerige Doppelsticke Alt and matured in cognac barrels. Uerige Doppelsticke Alt was created and designed by Uerige Obergearige Hausbrauerei for B. United International, Inc. in the USA only!

Uerige Doppelsticke might just be "Germany's interpretation of the classic barley-wine style, ie a third definition next to England's "malt-driven" concoction {such as JW Lees Vintage Harvest Ale} and America's "hop-heavy" version {such as Sierra Nevada's BigFoot}.

Flavor	Oak & a medley of subtle plum flavors, nicely tempered with herbal bitterness.
Finish	Lasts forever. Starts with a spicy, oaken dominance then fades through citrus peel into a finale of tangerine, golden raisin, tarragon, and subdued hint of pistachio.

The Uerige Single Malt Whisky

Our unique Single Malt Whisky, carefully distilled right in the heart of the famous Düsseldorf Altstadt, impresses through its absolutely balanced character, its uncompromising individuality and a sympathetic smoothness. In contrast to our distant scottish competitors,

our Chief Distiller filters the mash we use for our whisky – thus, all glumes are removed in order to avoid any risk of none-noble flavors. Furthermore, we only use the still’s middle-run and forgo the less sublime forerun and after-run. After 36 months of maturation in american white oak casks, the whisky is put down upon its ideal drinking strength, 42,5 % alc/vol, and bottled in its pure, non-filtered, simple beauty. Presently, BAAS is the world’s rarest contemporary Single Malt Whisky. Its availability, therefore, is lamentably quite limited.
