In 1851 the first beer was filled in bottles in the Einbecker steam beer brewery. And from the beginning the "Original Einbecker Bottle" is used. The design of the bottle has not changed since then, and it has become one of the symbols of the Einbecker

Flavor: Spicy noble hops, grass, and minerals are present. Even though the hoppy taste is not as bold as in the aroma, hoppy still drives the flavor.
